

Administration of Medication:

At Kangaroo's Korner, medication will be administered to a child only upon written request of the parent and the child's primary care giver. The parents and primary care provider complete the request to administer medication.

The form is located inside the office.

- The parents will bring the considered request to administer Medication form and the medication in its original child-resistant safety container with the original prescription label identifying the child's name. Medications will only be administered for up to one month from the date on the container for antibiotics and within the expiration date for all other medications.

Child Requirements:

- ▶ Each child must have a medical examination and provide the center with a report prior to being admitted. A physical form will be provided.
- ▶ Each child must provide the center with an immunization record prior to enrollment.
- ▶ An enrollment packet consisting of a child fact sheet, health Information, consent and authorization sheets must be completed and returned to the center prior to the child's start date.

Attendance/Sick Policy

- ▶ Children need to be dropped off by 10 a.m. Children coming in after 10 a.m. cause a distraction throughout the building and their classroom. Just like adults, children feel more confident and secure when their daily activities are predictable and familiar.
- ▶ If your child will not attend on a given day, or arrive late (Doctor/dentist/therapy) please notify the office no later than 9 a.m.

* A child with a temperature of 101 degrees or higher, diarrhea or vomiting should not be sent to the center. If your child has been diagnosed as having a contagious disease, please advise the center. Sick children must remain home for 24 hours, and they must be a symptom free 24 hours before returning.
